P.E. REPORT (BOYS)

During the 1st Term the School Rugby team, which started this year, played a series of games against R.A.C. and Army units. Out of five games played the school won 2, lost 2, drew 1. The school also played two games against Changi Grammar School winning both games.

The Junior (4th Form) Rugby team played four games winning each one.

At the end of the first term the Rugby Inter-House Competition was held and in the final Dover House beat Belvoir House 14 points - 5 points.

During the Second Term the School Soccer team participated in the Pasir Panjang District Soccer Competition, and after a series of seven games, emerged as the winners having won all seven games. The team then went forward to represent the Pasir Panjang District in the Singapore Combined Schools Competition. The school team reached the final and in a hard and exciting game at Jalan Besar Stadium they were beaten 4 - 0 by St. Thomas School, Serangoon.

In the Inter-House Soccer Competition held during the Second Term, Richborough House and Hastings House played out a non-scoring draw to share the Soccer trophy.

The Inter-House Basketball Tournament, which was held during lunch hours, resulted in Dover House beating Hastings House by 42 points - 22 points.

The Inter-House Cross Country Race was held in the school grounds with a course of 2 miles (approx) for the Junior Race (4th Form boys) and a 3 mile course for the Senior Race (5th and 6th Form boys).

The Pasir Panjang District Cross Country Race was held during the second term. In the Senior Race the School team was first. In the Junior Race the School team was third.

The School team took part in the Singapore Combined Schools Race. The winner was P. Allen and the team finished third out of 10 teams.

During the first and second terms the school took part in a series of Road Relay Races organised by the Singapore Combined Schools. The School team finished fourth out of fifty teams.

In the Singapore Amateur Athletic Association Cross Country Championships the School team finished third out of six teams.

During the third term the School took part in the Pasir Panjang District Athletic Meeting. Among the outstanding competitors were P. Allen who won 800m, 1500m and 3000m, N. Thomson who was second in the 800m and 1500m and K. Collins who was second in the Discus. The School team was second in the 4 x 100m Relay and 4 x 400m Relay.

The School Sports which were held on the School Fields resulted in the Combined Boarding Houses winning with 173½ and Warwick House Second with 163.
